Overview

The course is practical and links directly to current practice in the music industry. There is no external examination - 100% Externally Assessed

The course consists of practical sessions, lectures, workshops and live performances. Studies include: composition, professional practice in the music industry, and music and instrumental technical development.

Classes are made up of students who play a range of different instruments and who have diverse musical interests. Students can learn through whatever musical style they like and the choice of performance material is student-led.

Extracurricular music activities include: Rock school, Senior Choir, A Cappella Choir, Ukulele Club, 'The Acting Studio', Male Vocal Zone, Girl's Vox, Dance Company, Ballet and Tap Technique, Keyboard Club, Samba, Wind Band and Music Theory Zone.

Your time at Cowley Sixth Form will be full of challenges with plenty of rewards on offer in an environment that is both fun and hardworking, and with a schedule that is guaranteed to stretch you beyond your wildest dreams.

Support
