Professional Development

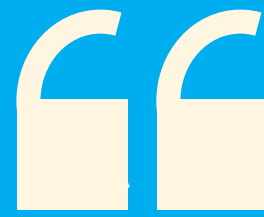
You will be taught by an enthusiastic and caring team who are committed to providing a platform from which you can choose a suitable career pathway.
