CONSTRUCTION

Overview

During the one-year course, you will experience a range of construction tasks including: Bricklaying, Carpentry, Painting, Decorating, Plastering, Plumbing and Electrical installations.

Students will have the opportunity to experience working within the construction environment by completing two days of work placement each week, with the remaining three days of the week spent in College.

Students will be taught by an experienced and enthusiastic team who teach a range of practical tasks, from small to full scale.

Lessons will incorporate a mix of practical and theory work.

Support

Students will receive training before being offered the opportunity to sit their CSCS Health and Safety card examinations which is required for some work experience placements.

Placements will be organised by the College's Work Related Learning Mentor, who works extensively with employers in the local area to secure a range of work placements for students and provides support while students are on work placements. The college will endeavour to provide students with a minimum of one work placement, but any additional placements may have to be sourced by the student and student led placements within the Construction sector are highly recommended.



Equipment that you will need

Recommended PPE

- Safety boots/Safety glasses (one set of boots will be provided by the College, but it is recommended students invest in their own safety equipment)
- Mandatory – suitable work pants, t-shirt and jumper/fleece

Without suitable clothing, students will not be allowed in the workshops for practicals.

Previous students have secured full time jobs within the Construction Industry as well as gaining work experience with employers which have enabled the students to progress to apprenticeships with their work experience employer,
